The **Casino Historical Museum** has a comprehensive collection of articles and material connected with the origins of Casino and surrounding district that reflects the lifestyle of early residents.

There is something for everyone to see and appreciate. It's a wonderful opportunity to bring back memories to the older visitor and provides a learning and discovery experience for others.

The Museum display includes:

- Aboriginal artefacts and early photographs
- Machinery and implements from an era gone by, including a rare bullock plough
- Coach lamps, horse and bullock harnesses
- Cooking utensils, including unique, home made household articles
- Early household china and linen
- Clothing, hats and shoes from 18-1900's
- Pianos, pianolas and other musical instruments
- Trade tools and equipment used in the past
- Honour boards from the district halls, schools and lodges
- The history of early properties and squatters
- Numerous photographs of early buildings, businessmen and residents

Guided Heritage Walks

The Society conducts heritage walks around the town covering three different routes.

All walks are on level ground and the estimated time, at a leisurely pace, is around 1.5 hours for each walk.

The Beginnings

This walk shows the area where the town began and the sites of early buildings including those where the buildings no longer stand

Past and Present

This walk highlights interesting buildings and historical sites connected with both the past and present

Art Deco and Heritage

You'll be amazed at the architectural styles and the stories behind why and how this developed. The feature of this walk is the many art deco buildings and includes other historic buildings.

Brochures are available at the Museum for the three walks.



Groups are accompanied by a local guide who will talk on the historical sites and buildings.
